The collapse of editorial responsibility has resulted in declining transparency and accountability. The situation is a grave and urgent threat to a healthy public sphere that is essential for democracy in practice. Trustworthy, accurate, balanced, impartial and non-commercial news services are needed now more than ever - an historic strength and persistent mandate for PSM. Regrettably, growing commercial influence and waning political support increasingly threaten the viability of public service journalism today. RIPE@2022 is addressing these concerns.
